

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

CHATTANOOGA BICYCLE CLUB

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this organization shall be Chattanooga Bicycle Club.

ARTICLE II

Aims:

The aim of this organization shall be to promote the general interests of cycling in all its phases; to encourage and facilitate touring runs, cycle outings, cycle trains, and all forms of recreational cycling activities; to defend and protect the rights of cyclists; to secure a better understanding and recognition of the need for safer riding conditions; to encourage the allocation of facilities for cycling on public lands; to cooperate with the public authorities in the observance of all traffic regulations.

ARTICLE III

Membership:

Anyone over 14, who owns and rides a bicycle is eligible for membership. Children of parent members will always be welcome at Club activities.

ARTICLE IV

Officers:

The following officers shall be elected by the membership. These officers, together with the chairmen of club committees, shall constitute the Executive Board. (1) President (2) Vice President (3) Secretary-Treasurer (4) Road Captain.

The captain controls all Club runs. The Secretary Treasurer keeps a roll of the members, takes care of all money and collects all the dues; notifies the members of dates of meetings and Club runs, and keeps a record of the meetings and runs.

ARTICLE V

Dues:

Club dues shall be \$1.00 per year, payable monthly to the treasurer.

ARTICLE VI

Elections:

Election of club officers shall be held annually. A nominating committee appointed by the president shall present

a list of candidates for the offices to be filled. Additional names may be placed in nomination from the floor immediately prior to the election. A plurality vote shall be necessary to elect. Installation of the officers-elect shall take place at the first regular meeting following the election.

ARTICLE VII

Meetings:

Regular meetings shall be held ~~bi~~ monthly on the last Monday of every ~~other~~ month, beginning June, 1967. Special meetings shall be called by the President whenever required. The annual meeting shall be the last meeting of the fiscal year.

ARTICLE VIII

Order of Business:

The order of business at regular meetings shall be:

1. Roll Call
2. Reading of Minutes of previous meeting
3. Report of officers and committees
4. Unfinished business
5. Proposal and election of new members
6. New business
7. Announcement of runs, special meetings, etc..
8. Adjournment

ARTICLE IX

Quorum:

A quorum of the membership for the purpose of conducting club business shall consist of not less than 25 percent of the entire membership.

Amendments:

Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed by any members and may be incorporated into this Constitution if approved by a two-thirds vote of the entire membership.
