
Marty Pinson had the most lights. He even had them under his bike jersey!

Thursday, Dec 6, 10:30 AM - Urban Ride - VW/Collegedale/Apison Loop - This ride takes us through the round-a-bouts on Volkswagen Drive, down the Wolftever Greenway in Collegedale and for a loop in the country. It's a 31.5 mile ride with a few hills, but nothing too horrible. We'll have an overall average of 11-13mph by the end of the ride. There will be multiple stopping places for restroom breaks and regrouping. No drop ride.

Meet at the Redoubt Soccer parking lot on Bonnie Oaks Dr. There are two lots, we'll be at the one directly across from the entrance to Enterprise South. Wheels hit the pavement at 10:30 am.

Lunch, after the ride, will be at The City Café! ("Let them eat cake!")

Friday, Dec 7, 10:30 AM - Riverpark Twenty or Thirty Mile Leisure Ride - This ride consists of two loops. The first loop is a leisurely ride that follows the Riverwalk from the Hubert Fry Center to the Wheland Foundry Station in St. Elmo, and then returns to Hubert Fry Center. The ride has a "bring your own snack" stop at the Blue Goose Hollow Station on the way back from St. Elmo. Near the end of the loop, riders have the option of either heading back to Hubert Fry Center, or adding the second loop, a ten mile ride that follows the South Chickamauga Creek Greenway. 20 or 30 miles (Rider choice!), 9-10 mph, no drop. The average speed for the second loop will be a bit higher!
